THE FLEISCHMANN CENTENARY DIGITISATION PROJECT 2010 – 2015

The Fleischmann family is deeply grateful to all those who have supported this project. Among the institutions and individuals who set it up, supported and contributed to it are:

Cork City Council

The Cork City Council Fleischmann Centenary Working Group, chaired by Dr Máirín Quill, funded the digital typesetting of four compositions, the scores and parts of which were so fragile that they could not otherwise have been performed at the centenary concerts.

Cork City Libraries

The idea of setting up a Fleischmann website on which the digitised scores could be placed came from Cork City Libraries. The director, Liam Ronayne, and the director of the Music Library, Kitty Buckley, formulated the aim of making the Fleischmann musical legacy freely available on the website. They initiated a digitisation project, in cooperation with Aidan O'Carroll of Tralee and the Fleischmann family, inviting musicians familiar with the relevant software to consider offering their services to typeset the works. The success has been extraordinary. Kitty Buckley herself personally scanned every single one of Fleischmann's manuscript scores and placed them on the website before her retirement from the Music Library. 30 musicians have volunteered their services; we hope that by the end of 2016 the entire oeuvre will be available with all the scores newly typeset and the digital files downloadable free of charge. Aloys Fleischmann may well be the only Irish composer of the 20th century whose complete works have been published in this manner.

The Digitisation Project continues for Aloys Fleischmann Senior. 24 of his compositions have been typeset; many of the works currently on the website in manuscript form need to be digitised. The family would greatly appreciate any help that can be given in this undertaking.

CIT Cork School of Music

Dr Geoffrey Spratt, director of the School, arranged to have a work by Fleischmann Junior and one by Fleischmann Senior typeset for centenary performances in Cork and in Dachau. The first typesetting of a Fleischmann work was undertaken in 2004 by Alan Cutts.

The Contemporary Music Centre of Ireland

The Centre had a Fleischmann work typeset and published in its *Choirland Anthology of Irish Choral Music* in 2012.

The Music Department of the University of Durham

Dr Patrick Zuk arranged for the typesetting of works by Fleischmann Senior and Hans Conrad Swertz for recitals in Cork and for performance at the Festival of Irish Music held during the First International Conference on Irish Music at Durham University in July 2010.

The Vanbrugh Quartet

Keith Pascoe typeset Fleischmann's Movement for String Quartet for its first public performance at University College Cork in April 2010.
